How to find us

#### The Leys School, Trumpington Road, Cambridge, CB2 7AD

From the South – Use M11, exit at Junction 11, follow Trumpington Road towards city centre. Driving time from M25 approx. 40-50 minutes.

From the North – Use A1/A14, join M11, exit at Junction 12, follow Barton Road towards city centre, then take Fen Causeway.

From the West – Use A428 (or A14), join M11, exit at Junction 12, follow Barton Road towards city centre, then take Fen Causeway.

From the East – Use A14, join M11, exit at Junction 12, follow Barton Road towards city centre, then take Fen Causeway.

Park and ride – Cambridge P&R operates from all major entry routes into the city. We recommend using Trumpington P&R, which has a bus stop immediately outside of The Leys (not available after 8pm).

Sat Nav – Our post code is CB2 7AD but please be aware that this will take you to the Trumpington Road entrance.

### Arriving:

- Coaches and minibuses should drop off at the sports hall car park. Coaches will then need to leave the site and park at Barton Road layby and then the opposition staff can phone them when they are ready to be collected. Spectators can park here or at Latham road sports possible.
- Visiting teams will be met by a Leys Sport staff member at the car park

### First aid:

• We have pitch side first aiders for rugby, hockey, netball and football matches. If an injury occurs during a fixture, they will be on hand to help.

### Match teas:

- Pupils will receive hot match teas after fixtures (in the Michaelmas and In the summer term cold teas are provided in the Sports Pavilion. Vegan/ vegetarian options are available.
- Refreshments for spectators will be in the Sports Pavilion during fixtures. A coffee truck is normally based at Latham road sports pitches on Saturday's and sells hot drinks and cakes.
