



Silent Auction Terms and Conditions

These terms and conditions apply to all attendees participating in The Leys School Silent Auction. By placing a bid, you agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. Definitions

- 1.1 **'Lot(s)'** – refers to any item, experience or service offered for bidding at the silent auction.
- 1.2 **'Donor(s)'** – refers to the individual or organisation that has provided a Lot for auction.
- 1.3 **'Auction'** – refers to the silent auction taking place at the Parent Ball on 27 March 2025.
- 1.4 **'the School'** – refers to The Leys School, who is facilitating the Auction.

2. Bidding and Payment

- 2.1 All bids are final and legally binding. By placing a bid, you agree to pay the full amount if you are the winning bidder.
- 2.2 The highest bid at the close of the Auction will be deemed the winning bid.
- 2.3 Payment must be made **on the night**. If this is not possible, payments must be made within 5 working days of the Auction.
- 2.4 If payment is not received within the specified timeframe, the School reserves the right to offer the item to the next highest bidder.
- 2.5 The School accept the following payment methods:
 - 2.5.1 Cheque (made payable to The Leys School);
 - 2.5.2 Cash;

- 3.3 If payment has not been received within 5 working days of the Auction, the School reserves the right to request the return of the Lot(s) or offer the item to the next highest bidder.

4. Lot Descriptions and Liability

- 4.1 All Lots are described as accurately as possible. The School provides no guarantees, warranties or servicing of Lots.
- 4.2 Any experiences or vouchers won are subject to the terms and conditions of the provider and must be redeemed within their stated validity period.
- 4.3 Where the experience/service must be booked directly with the Donor, this is subject to the availability and terms set by the Donor. Any changes, cancellations or special requests must be agreed directly with the Donor.
- 4.4 The School is not liable for any personal injury or damage to property that may result from the Lot.
- 4.5 Once a Lot is won and paid for, no refunds or exchanges will be given.
